

## **MESSAGES**


Please ensure that your contact details are kept up to date with us at school. We send general school messages via epraise and email but will contact you on the phone to talk about urgent or individual matters, and this is how we would contact you in an emergency. We need to have two sets of contact details on our system for each pupil. If any of your contact details have changed recently, please let us know at the school office on 01527 525725 or by email office@ipsleyacademy.co.uk.

A reminder to families that all pupils should be on the school site for 08:30AM in the morning, ready for learning to begin at 08:40AM. We are so pleased that almost every pupil has been here before 08:30AM so far this week - thank you! Pupils who arrive after 08:30AM will need to arrive via the front gate as the back gate will close just after this time. Please note this is slightly earlier than the previous time of 08:40AM. If pupils are later to school than 08:40AM, then we are required to formally record this as a late mark on your child's attendance record.

We want to ensure all pupils are presented in full school uniform so that there is no distraction from learning throughout the school day - an enormous thank you to our school community for helping us, as almost every pupil has returned to school this term in immaculate uniform! A reminder of our uniform expectations is available on our school website. Where pupils arrive to school in incorrect uniform, they will usually be loaned correct uniform for the day and may be issued a consequence if there is not an agreed reason.

Please note that hoodies and branded tracksuits are not allowed and will be confiscated - pupils can wear a coat or fleece on cold days if they wish, rather than a tracksuit top. Pupils should be wearing plain black socks (not fluffy please!), and plain black or navy jogging bottoms, leggings or shorts (no logos, stripes or mesh panels) on PE days. Skirts should reach the knee. Appropriate trainers can be worn on PE days - please avoid crocs, converse and sliders as these are not appropriate for PE activities! If you need any support with purchasing school uniform, please contact the school office.
