Across the autumn term, we have been introducing a range of intervention programmes to support our students in making the best possible progress across their final two years of KS2.

Following assessment, we feel your child would benefit from joining the Fresh Start phonics intervention. This is a reading recovery programme aimed at supporting students who can struggle to read fluently. The intervention is delivered during the school day by a specialist member of staff in groups of four or less.

We expect most children to make rapid progress on this intervention, meaning that they will catch up with their peers quickly. For some students, it may be appropriate to continue following the programme as part of our special educational needs provision. If this is the case, the school's special educational needs co-ordinator will be in touch to discuss support for your child.

In order to support your child at home, please continue to read with them on a nightly basis and encourage them to sound out their words correctly.
