### All Things Wild - 9<sup>th</sup> March 2018

Year 5 are looking forward to their trip on Friday to **All Things Wild**. Ahead of the day, we would like to advise you of a few things that your child will need.

- Children should come to school, as usual, promptly at 8.30am
- Children should be dressed in non-uniform. With recent cold temperatures and rain forecast we ask that they have plenty of layers, hats, scarfs and a warm raincoat. We will be outdoors and moving about for most of the day so comfy and waterproof shoes are also essential (Umbrellas, Wellington boots or old trainers are also advised).
- Please provide a packed lunch, placed in a small bag that your child can carry. If your child has free school meals, a packed lunch will be provided. Fizzy/energy drinks are not allowed.
- Children will have the opportunity to visit the pocket money shop and should bring no more than £5.00, in a named purse/ wallet. Your child will be responsible for their own money.
- Children will be provided with a laminated contact card with key emergency numbers on to be used in an emergency only.
- Mobile phones are permitted on this trip. Phones must be turned off at all times, except in emergencies and failure to comply with this request may mean that children do not go on subsequent trips. Children will need to be responsible for their own phones and we accept no responsibility for them should they be lost or damaged.
- Any medication should be clearly labelled. If travel sickness tablets are needed, they should be taken well before travel. Any tablets supplied for the way back, need to be in a named envelope with clear instructions.
