## Maths

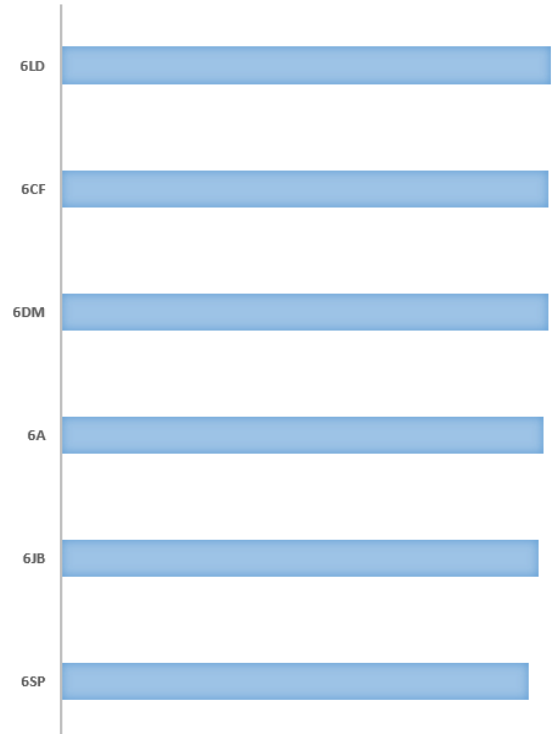
