

Year 5 All Things Wild Trip

Dear Parent/Carer,

To end our Survivors topic, we have planned an amazing trip to All Things Wild for Year 5 on Tuesday 26th March 2019. All Things Wild is a nature centre situated in Honeybourne near Evesham. It has a growing collection of rare and exotic animals, birds, reptiles and the children will have the opportunity to see some of the animals they have been learning about in the classroom.

There will be an animal handling experience for all the children where they will learn about some of the animals and maybe get to hold them so please make us aware of any allergies or worries before our visit so we can accommodate them as best we can. All Things Wild also have 25 life-sized model dinosaurs and the children will follow the Dino trail finding clues about the dinosaurs to win a prize. The cost per child is £13.00, which covers entry, the animal handling session, the coach and insurance. This must be paid via ParentPay by Friday 1st March. All children will need to bring a packed lunch and a drink with a screw cap. If your child is in receipt of free school meals, lunch will be provided. (We are able, on this occasion, to offer the trip at a reduced rate of £8.00 for children who are eligible for Free School Meals.) If possible, we would like all of Year 5 to attend. Any problems please don't hesitate to get in touch with Mr Hylton or Miss Davies.

The children will not be required to wear their normal school uniform as the centre and the activities are based outside and they could get dirty. They will be required to **wear their PE top and a sensible pair of trousers that they don't mind getting dirty – jeans or joggers**. They **MUST** bring a **waterproof coat** with them as it could rain and many of the activities are outside. If they do not bring it to school on the morning of the trip, they may not be allowed to go, even if the weather is fine in Redditch. They must also wear sensible, waterproof shoes like trainers or boots. If your child would like to take Wellington Boots as well, that would be acceptable.

There will be a pocket money shop with items up to £2.00 on sale. The children can bring up to £5 maximum with them and it must be in a named purse or wallet and it will be their responsibility to look after it throughout the day.

The trip will be within school hours so all children will need to come to school at the normal time – 8.30am – and will be back in time to go home as normal. We will be leaving at 9.15am and returning by 3pm.

Please remember to make the payment by Friday 1st March and fill in the consent form attached.
