We have planned a theatre trip to Birmingham Rep Theatre, on the evening of Thursday, 26th September 2019 to see 'Mushy – Lyrically Speaking'. The trip will support pupils' confidence, their learning in English and RE as well as seeing the many different careers that are open to them such as acting, public speaking and technical support, e.g. lighting, sound etc.

Pupils should return to school in their school uniform ready for a 6pm departure. We will travel to Birmingham by school minibuses for the performance at 7:45 pm. The performance is due to finish at approximately 10.00pm, so we should return to school by 11pm, traffic permitting.

The play follows the story of Musharaf Asghar:

'An uplifting tale inspired by the true story of Musharaf Asghar (Educating Yorkshire).

Dewsbury, 2013. Mushy, a young man with a debilitating stammer, finds himself at the centre of a television documentary. In a moment of inspiration from his teacher, Mr. Burton, he starts to find a rhythm in his voice through music. Social media erupts hailing it a miracle cure and both teacher and pupil become overnight celebrities. But Mushy's journey to find his voice has only just begun...'
