Red Nose Day for Comic Relief – Friday 19th March 2021 – Non-uniform day

In the past we have asked for £1, however, this year, whilst £1 is still the recommended amount, any donation will be accepted – we just want #TeamIpsley to do what we can to support this great cause!

Ipsley have set up a school donations page for Comic Relief. The minimum donation possible on this page is £1. This is the school's preferred method for donations as it makes the money transactions contactless and the charity is able to claim an extra 25% on what is donated through the site, which of course makes a tremendous difference.
